Mua Mission Hospital has a history of more than 100 years. It was founded at the start of the 20th century by the White Fathers and is today serving a population of nearly 30.000 people. It is beautifully located just on the slopes of the Rift Valley Escarpment.

The hospital has a bed capacity of 140 beds. It is a fully equipped, general hospital comprising a maternity and paediatric ward, a male and female ward, a TB - and private ward, an OPD, pharmacy, laboratory, X-ray and ultrasound facilities and 2 new roomy surgical theatres.

Mua Hospital is chronically understaffed and currently there are three medical doctor vacancies in the hospital.

Tweega Medica is a small Dutch non-profit organization that strives to improve the health of the most vulnerable inhabitants of Eastern Africa by sending broadly trained medical doctors to rural hospitals. They provide hands-on clinical care as well as contribute to education and training of local health workers. Tweega Medica has an impressive track record for enabling Dutch tropical doctors on their long-term, sustainable contributions to existing local health care infrastructure in Tanzania, Uganda, Kenya and Malawi.

TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

CLINICAL WORK

Together with the rest of the hospital team you collaborate in all the clinical work and direct patient care. Currently there is one other MD working in the hospital and there are 9 clinical officers.

TEACHING AND TRAINING

Together with the other doctor you will supervise all other health workers in the hospital. You're willing to do a lot on-the-job/bedside teaching and are willing to invest in organising and giving lectures (subject depending on local demand) and share your knowledge with the hospital staff.



When you are interested in obstetrics, pediatrics, surgery, teaching, public health and have finished the Dutch course in tropical medicine and hygiene (or similar training), we encourage you to apply.
